Recommendation for seniors with a semester average of "A" could be exempt from each semester exam

Keep weighted classes, but recommend follow up study

Recommendation to have honor graduates: 3.5-3.75 Distinction and 3.8-4.00 High Distinction. The council recommended this proposal starting with the freshmen class of 1991-92 there will be no valedictorian or salutatorian

The grading policy should use numerical grades on report cards and permanent records

The grading policy should have rounded off to two digits

Semester average should be determined by counting each nine weeks twice, semester exam once, and dividing by five for an average

Year average should be determined by taking each semester grade and adding together and dividing by two

Suggestions to add to curriculum were discussed. The relocation of the weight room complex was discussed. Baker is going to speak to each of the booster organizations to discuss helping with

the labor of refurbishing and relocating weight room.

Reid, chairman of the council, recommended the position of chemistry/science teacher to Suzanne Dutton.
