The commercial producer award recognizes the producer that has demonstrated the improved production and made an outstanding contribution to the cattle industry. Garry Rector has demonstrated these qualities during his farming life, most notably in the last five years. While Garry has been involved in farming for many years, he became farm manager five years ago for Eaglestone Farm, a thoroughbred horse and stocker cattle operation. At Eaglestone, Garry has introduced innovative beef management practices to the farming operation. Through Garry's implementation of an intensive grazing program, he began with 80 acres in 1988 and has built to 410 acres in 1990. Beef production increased on the farm from less than 100 lbs. in 1985 to 487 lbs. per acre of grade beef in 1990. Garry Rector has also established a complete and nutrition program, plus maximizing forage production.
