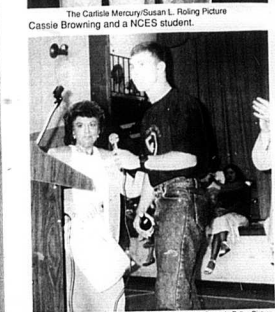
Cassie Browning comes home to hear cheers and praise
