Continued from Page 17 manhole or upon samples taken at the control manhole. In the event that no special control manhole has been required, the control manhole shall be considered to be the nearest downstream manhole in the public sewer to the point at which the building sewer is connected. (C) Grease, oil, or sand interceptors shall be provided when, in the opinion of the city, they are necessary for the protection of the public sewer system from wastes containing grease in excessive amounts, or any flammable waste, sand, or other harmful ingredients, except that interceptors shall not be required for private living quarters or dwelling units. Where installed, they shall be maintained by the owner at his expense in continuously effective operation at all times. SECTION 3. That violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall carry the penalties set forth in Section 51.99, and each day continuing shall constitute a separate offense.
