**Nicholas Facts .....**

Carlisle, Kentucky, the county seat of Nicholas County, is located in the Outer Blue Grass Region of Central Kentucky. Carlisle is located 36 miles northeast of Lexington, Kentucky; 103 miles southeast of Cincinnati, Ohio; 105 miles east of Louisville, and 205 miles north of Knoxville, Tennessee.

Although 1990 is a census year, according to the latest figures available, 1984, the City of Carlisle, had an estimated population of 1,633. The complete recapitulation and final accounting should be available in 1992.

Nicholas County covers a land area of 197 square miles of rolling to hilly terrain. In 1986, Nicholas County had an estimated population of 7,200, but preliminary figures show a reduction in that number by 1991.

**Recreation**  
Recreational facilities in Nicholas County include three parks. The East End Recreational Park includes a ball field, a tennis court, two basketball courts, a playground, and a skate board ramp.

**Transportation and Services**  
**Education and Climate**

Main line rail service is provided to Carlisle by TTI Systems, Inc. U.S. 68, a "AAA" - related (80,000 pound gross load limit) trucking highway located three miles west of Carlisle, is the principal highway serving Carlisle and Nicholas County.

In addition, Carlisle is served directly by Kentucky Highways 13, 36 and 32.

Interchanges with Interstate 64 and Interstate 76 are located 30 miles southwest of Carlisle. An additional Interstate 64 interchange is located 24 miles south of Carlisle in Montgomery County, and 25 miles east of Carlisle in Bath County.

Electric power is provided to Carlisle and parts of Nicholas County by Kentucky Utilities. Nicholas County is also provided electric power by Harrison R.E.C.C. and Fleming Mason R.E.C.C.

Natural gas service is provided by the City of Carlisle Gas System. Public water supply is available in Nicholas County from the Nicholas County Water District, the Fleming County Water

District and the Sharpshurg Water District. The City of Carlisle Wastewater Treatment Plant serves the city.

Both facilities have undergone renovation and improvement in the past three years.

Primary and secondary public education is provided by the Nicholas County School System. In addition, 10 institutions of higher learning are located within 60 miles of Carlisle. Vocational training facilities are available in Cynthiana and Lexington, both within 40 miles of Carlisle. Morehead State University offers some off campus education in Nicholas County as does Masseyville Community College.

The average temperature of Nicholas County is 54.9 degrees. The highest recorded temperature is 103 degrees in 1983 and the lowest is 21 below zero in 1963.

The average rainfall is 45.68 inches per year.

The average relative humidity is 70 percent.

**Government Structures**  
The City of Carlisle is served by a mayor for the duration of a four year term, and six council members, each serving two years terms.
