

Brookshire wins W.T. Young scholarship

Ruby Brookshire of Nicholas County High School, is one of 25 high school seniors who will enter Transylvania University next fall as W.T. Young Scholars.

Young Scholars receive scholarship covering tuition, fees, and room and board over a period of four years, giving each scholarship a value of over \$10,000.

The scholarship recipient is an outstanding high school senior who displays extraordinary academic ability, a solid character and strong leadership.

The most scholarship program was established by Transylvania in 1937 as the Thomas Jefferson Scholars Program but became the William T. Young Scholars program July 1, 1988.

The action was taken by the Transylvania Board of Trustees in recognition of Mr. Young's contributions to the school. Mr. Young, a Lexington businessman, is chairman of Transylvania's Board of Trustees.

Finalists were invited to visit Transylvania prior to a personal interview in which the scholarship selection committee based its final decision.

Charles L. Shearer said the scholarship recipient will make positive contributions to the university.

The new Young Scholars have an average ACT score of 30.

Brookshire was one of 25 scholars selected from 354 applicants.
