Fryman takes win in Nicholas Clerk's race

CARLSLE — Doug Fryman, who had been appointed to the Nicholas County Clerk's position until the primary election, won the right to fill the unexpired term of Rose Scott who retired.

Fryman had been appointed by Nicholas County Judge Executive Reese Smoot. Shirley Gardner, former secretary to Smoot, had challenged

for the position, along with three others who entered the race. Third place finisher was Mona Vice, fourth was William Crawford and Layne Gray will fill.

Fryman, 43, lives on Concord Road. Following his win, Fryman said, "I am glad it is over."

Several races too close to call

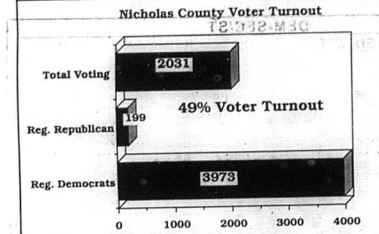
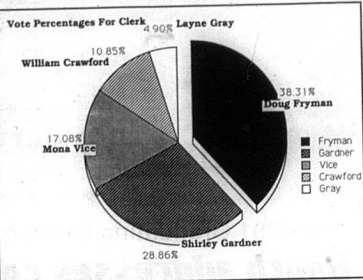

Jones wins, republicans in dead heat

ACROSS KENTUCKY, Popular three term Lexington Mayor Scotty Baesler captured the Nicholas County vote, but failed in his bid to win the democratic nomination, Tuesday, as Lt. Governor Breton Jones captured the right to challenge either U.S. Representative Larry Hopkins or Larry Furgis in the November General Election.

At 10 p.m., the race was the dead heat, with 50 percent of the vote going to each candidate.

Nicholas County backs Baesler, Hopkins

She withdrew from the race, May 10.

Baesler conceded victory to Jones at 8:50 p.m., election night, trailing statewide, 37 to 31 percent, with about 70 percent of the vote counted.

"We have a lot of fun working across the state," Baesler said to reporters.

"We did extremely well around here, so that was a consolation prize."

Some in the audience yelled, "What about four years?"

Baesler was quick to respond, "I don't know, I'm going back to the tobacco!"

Jones failed to win a single precinct in Nicholas County, but did tie Baesler in absentee voting with eight.

Speaking to supporters at his campaign headquarters, Jones said, "There's no better feeling on election night than to win."
