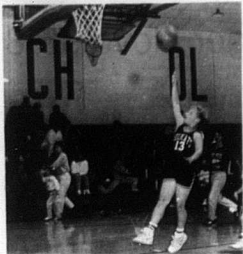

The Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Cabinet, Division of Waste Management, recently received a Notice of Intent Application from Mason County Fiscal Court.

The permit applicant is proposing to construct a Contained Landfill solid waste disposal facility located in Mason County, Kentucky. The proposed facility may be accessed from the intersection U.S. 68 and the AA Highway in Maysville, Kentucky, go west approximately five miles and turn right (south) onto Clarkson-Sherman Road, go along this road approximately one-half mile and proposed landfill site will be on your left. The proposed facility may also be accessed from Orangeburg, Kentucky go northwest on KY 1449 to its intersection with KY 1448, then turn left onto KY 1448, go until it intersects with Clarkson-Sherman Road, turn left onto Clarkson-Sherman Road, go along this road approximately one-half mile and the proposed site will be on your left. The permit applicant proposes to accept household, commercial, municipal, institutional and industrial solid wastes from the following sources: Mason, Robertson, Fleming, Bracken, Lewis and Nicholas Counties in Kentucky.
