The morning update will give corrected figures for the previous day's sales increase the Kentucky Belt and in Kentucky. The late afternoon update will give current information for all that day's sales, corrected figures from the previous day's sales and some grade averages. As 5:00 p.m., the sales figures from each market and the day's averages will be available on the hotline. The hotline will be in operation until the end of the marketing season in early 1992.

Updated news from Kentucky's tobacco markets will be available each day of the market season. The Tobacco Information System, Department of Agriculture and the Federal Tobacco Market News Service, can be reached by dialing 1-800-432-9252. The hotline is free of charge to all callers. Preliminary information on the barley market will be available November 20, and up-to-date information will be available after the market opens. Information on dark- and light- and air-cured tobaccos will be available as those markets open.
