Tobacco task force

The Kentucky Tobacco Task Force will visit tobacco warehouses in Winchester and Mt. Sterling on opening day of sales, November 20. The Task Force was created by the General Assembly and is made up of legislators from tobacco areas throughout the state. The Task Force was formed to address problems faced by tobacco farmers and the industry, and to defend the tobacco program because of its tremendous importance to Kentucky. The Task Force has held hearings throughout the state and holds monthly meetings to hear and address tobacco concerns. The Task Force has sponsored a study of the impact of tobacco on the State's economy. It assisted in development of the Tobacco Improvement Act of 1985. It has testified before the International Trade Commission on limiting tobacco imports and it sponsored the Conference and Hearing on opening day of sales, November 20. The Task Force will visit tobacco warehouses in Winchester and Mt. Sterling, 10:45 a.m., at Clay's Tobacco Warehouse, 1:45 p.m. at New Farmers Warehouse, and 2:15 at Growers Warehouse in Mt. Sterling. The trip to Winchester and Mount Sterling will provide an opportunity for legislators to see how tobacco sales are going, and to talk to farmers and others who work with tobacco about their counties.
