**REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS**

The Nicholas County Fiscal Court is seeking written proposals for the design, construction, and operation of a solid waste convenience center. The convenience center will be located on property provided by the Nicholas County Fiscal Court. The convenience center should be designed to accept residential/commercial waste generated within the boundaries of Nicholas County. The Nicholas County Fiscal Court makes no warranty convenience center. The County will implement a franchised collection system (non-mandatory) on January 1, 1992. All permitting, design, operation, transportation and disposal expenses should be considered by and paid for by the successful contractor. Respondents should provide three prices as follows:  
 1. Proposed cost if Nicholas County purchase the necessary equipment.  
 2. Proposed cost if Nicholas County leases the necessary equipment.  
 3. Proposed cost of hauling compacted waste away and disposing of it in a properly permitted landfill on per yard basis.  
 The proposal should be for period of five years with an option for an additional five year period. The convenience center should be in operation by the 1st day of January 1992. All proposals must be sealed and must be received by 4 p.m. (Carlisle time) on the 3rd of December 1991. The proposals will be opened at 6:30 p.m. on the 3rd of December 1991. The Nicholas County Judge/Executive will then send an appropriate notice to each offeror that the Nicholas County Fiscal Court selects for discussions.
