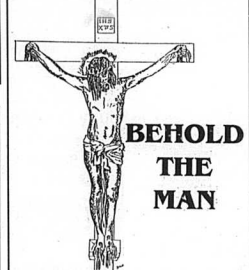

forces, Mike Wells, Staff Sergeant in charge of the unit, said Monday. According to wire reports within the last few months, the Pentagon has announced cut-backs in their numbers of National Guard and Reserve members. In Kentucky alone, nearly 684 positions in the Guard would be eliminated. However, Wells said, no unit cuts have been slated for the northeastern section of Kentucky, which are made up primarily of engineering corps members.

Wells also said the guard has not received any orders to curb recruitment efforts at all. But, there is a significant change in the criterion young men will have to meet before they can qualify for active service in the armed forces and avail themselves of the opportunities the United States military can offer young recruits.

The standard is simple: all new recruits must have a high school diploma, or at least a GED, Wells said. Not even servicemen trying to re-enlist into service can be admitted without proof of a complete high school education.

"The military is looking to favor quality over quantity with the new standards of recruitment in place. It used to be, as a recruiter, I was allowed to bring in only a limited number of recruits who had no high school diploma. But since last December, I am no longer allowed to accept them," Wells said.

The remaining acceptance tests are virtually the same, Wells said. New recruits must pass the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery, (ASVAB), as well as the physical exam.

"What most guard recruits are expected to do now is to go into some specialized training in the non-commissioned officers educational system. As the current time, I guess the Guard is looking not necessarily for numbers, but for an elite, specialized crew of people with developed abilities in a particular field.

"For those eligible, now really is the time to enter the National Guard. Not only can we provide you with experience and money to continue with higher education, but we provide education as well," Wells said.
