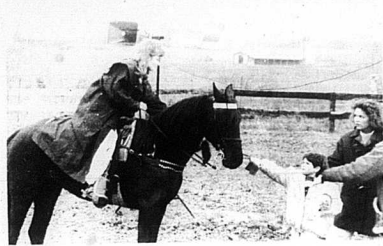


Lions Club Horse Show draws crowd despite the cold
