Council offers to take over water district

The Carlisle City Council has offered to purchase agreement between the city and the district, drawn up when the Nicholas County Water District was originally founded, would essentially be the city's agreement that they would supply water to serve district customers.

Council member Cartmell Lester expressed disappointment that Nicholas County has been sliced up by four separate water service organizations.

"It's ridiculous that we have so many water districts serving this county. It's not cost efficient and local government has lost revenue by not being more vigorous in getting utilities out to the public," Lester said.

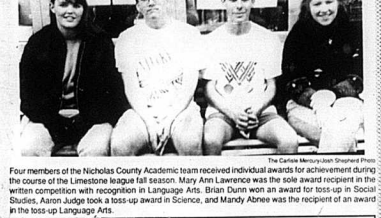
Council also expressed a desire to change some aspects of the original contract before they would enter into a new agreement.

The first would change a stipulation in the original contract which prevented council from raising rate on the district unless a similar rate hike was passed on to city residents.

"We just about break even on our expenses with the water plant in our present budget. If this council has to spend more on the water plant because we have to supply people out in the county, it's not fair to charge city people for it," Council member Bonnie Clark said.

Mayor Hughes agreed, but also felt that two water districts, the city and the Nicholas County Water District, have complicated matters and incurred unnecessary duplication of costs.

"In my opinion, the best thing all around is for the city to take over management of the existing water
