Honorary bearers were, W.H. Young, Custer Blair, Harold Letton, John B. Judy, John Schwickert, and Al Conway.

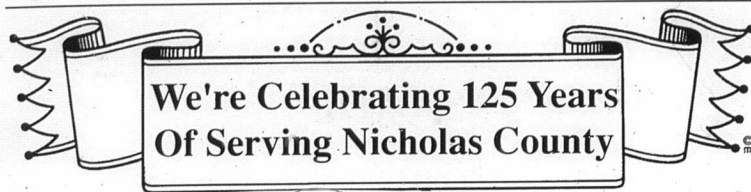
