Lawrence chosen to Governor's Scholar Program

CARLSLE — Nicholas County High School junior Mary Ann Lawrence was among the names of nearly 685 outstanding high school students selected to attend the 1992 Governor's Scholar Program this summer.

According to Governor Breten Jones, who released the names of the students last week in celebration of the program's 10th anniversary, said though the program itself offers neither grades or credit, the governor's scholar program offers a demanding, enriching academic experience.

Each scholar will spend five weeks in residence at either one of two Kentucky college campuses, Murray State University from June 29-July 26 or Centre College from June 29 - August 1. Lawrence was nominated as a potential candidate for the program early in the school year. Students are then selected by a statewide selection committee composed of college admissions directors, vice presidents, deans and professors as well as representatives from the Kentucky Department of Education and the Council on Higher Education.

Beside the academic courses students take to match their own particular interest, the program requires each student to participate in a general colloquium concentrating on a particular field completely different to them. A student strong in math, for example, would be placed in a colloquium in literature.

In addition the program will offer programs in three foreign languages, Russian, French, and Spanish, all taught by native speakers.

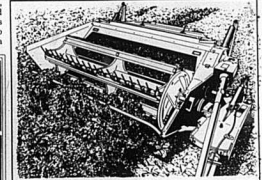
