

Earlywine's sawmill just a way to keep busy

Outside his house it has been raining on and off all day, the only weather that prevents him from doing anything. Even so, he fidgets, rubs his hands, anxious for any excuse to do something.

Several yards beyond the sawmill and rough cedar logs lie strewn along a rough carbon drive. Obscured by undergrowth, thin trees, and vines, it is a rustic looking wooden shed.

Beneath it lies an old sawmill, dry, silted, blanketed by a thin layer of fresh wood dust. It is a relic of the rain water spilling over the muddy yard where pick-ups have stopped to unload.

Because of the rain, Earlywine is impatient for the sun, for the clouds to break up and the ground to dry hard and sticky that he may start the motor of his Ford tractor and set the drive shaft spinning, powering the gears and the saw blade.

A rain-soaked afternoon is perhaps the only thing that keeps the high-pitched whine of a spinning blade slicing wood.

About 10 years ago, Earlywine bought the parts to the sawmill from Fred Jones in

Ellisville. Earlywine is not sure, but he thinks Bill Hillander owned the mill once. But when Earlywine bought it, the sawmill was mostly in pieces, he said. It was in good shape, protected from corrosion and rust inside a barn near Jones' house, Earlywine said.

He doesn't mind that traffic is nearly non-existent on the road nearby. Even before, when Sugar Creek Road went over his place, he said few cars for sale. He goes back to his carriage as the only sound.

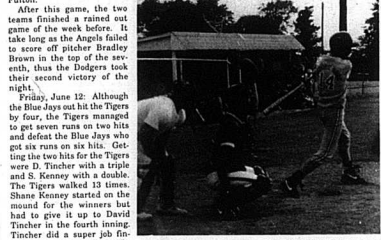
