The money goes to fund research in prevention and cure for all types of childhood cancer, as well as other incapacitating or killing childhood diseases. Saint Jude Children's Research Hospital was founded by the late Harry Thomas for the purpose of research and treatment of childhood cancer, especially those which lead to childhood death. Research and treatment has been expanded to include other childhood diseases such as childhood AIDS. All research findings are shared with other groups treating these diseases, and patients can find treatment at St. Jude in Memphis, Tennessee at no charge.
