the high school in the past two years than has been done in the last eight. I am very grateful to Mr. Gilbert, the board and the new Site Based Council for their work to improve this school," Reid said.

However, Reid said, problems far outweigh the improvements. Eight teachers have no classroom, he said, and there is no available space left to further improve the opportunities high school students deserve.

"I have utilized every available amount of space. We have crammed classes in the library, cafeteria, old weight room, coach's offices, and locker rooms. These places are not acceptable for the best atmosphere to educate our kids," Reid said.

Use of the gym has been a recurring problem for years,

Reid said. Parents and athletes have complained about the lack of space for girls, boys, JV, freshman, little league basketball, and cheerleaders to practice or have their games, he said.

"This is the reason students are always getting home from practices so late at night and why they have no time at all to study," Reid said.

"I have a classroom in the teachers dressing room with 12 students and no climate control."
Nicholas County School teacher Sandra Durham said, "A problem I have is I have one handicapped student who has to climb steps. This is, literally, a violation of the federal handicapped Discrimination Act and we could end up losing money because federal funding can be with-

held."
Gilbert said this could happen if the problem is not solved soon.

Nicholas County High School teacher Jim Simons asked about current fire safety inspections at the high school. Board member David Simot, a captain of the Bluegrass Army Depot said recent reports indicate the school is becoming more and more out of line with fire safety standards and equipment.

Nicholas County Elementary School Principal Gerald Hammans also commented on space problems at the elementary school which would be solved if the county had three schools.
"I do not have a closet in the building, because I have classes in the storage rooms. Also the junior high students do not need to be in the same school with kindergarten age children. There is further evidence that the education of seventh and eighth grade students is impaired by the lack of offerings available due to size restrictions," Hammans said.

It was apparent from the discussion that the need for a new school building on the Nicholas County campus was imperative and would grow more serious as the years went by.

"Right now is the best time for this school system to afford a school. Our ability to get the most money out of bond sales will lessen in the next several years and then you know how much it will cost to build a school. Prices rarely go down. This system can afford it," Gilbert said.

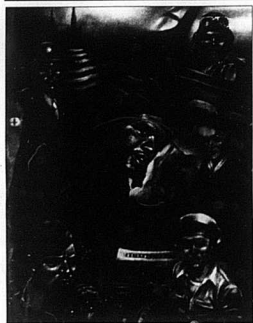
