Baesler, Ellinger to appear in special forum

Dr. John Shephard of the Fleming County Memorial Hospital and democratic national party representatives said.

The USWA forum appears to have broken an implacable stalemate between Baesler and Ellinger concerning the time and date of a debate.

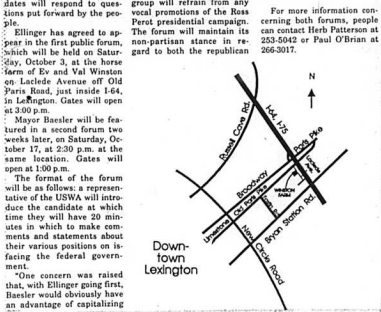
The intent of the forum is to remove the campaign of negative attacks and have candidates address and promote a positive discussion of the issues. People should choose candidates on the basis of how they stand, not on how well they can oppose their opponent's philosophy.

The alternative program, to which both candidates have agreed to appear, will be in the form of two public forums, free to the public, in which candidates will respond to questions posed by the audience.

Ellinger has agreed to appear at the first public forum, which will be held on Saturday, October 3, at the home farm of Ev and Val Winston on Laidlaw Avenue off Old Paris Road, just inside the town of Lexington. Gates will open at 10:00 p.m.

The format of the forum will be as follows: a representative of the USWA will introduce the candidate at which time they will have 20 minutes in which to make comments and statements about their various positions on issues facing the federal government.

"One concern was raised that with Ellinger going first, Baesler would obviously have an advantage of capitalizing
