Hughes said the car wash is the most up-to-date self-serve car wash available in the market. It also fills a gap left open by the dismantling of Crockett's Car Wash on the

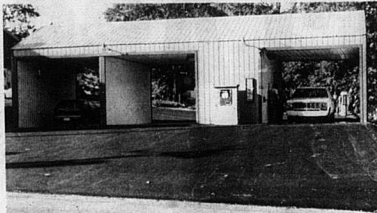
West End of Carlisle, making room for the new Chevron Station currently under construction.

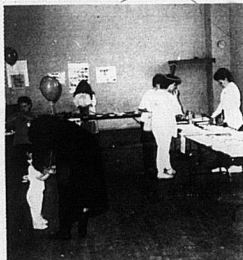

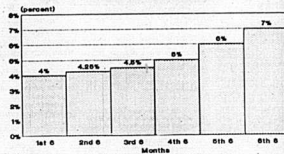
