Junior Lady Jackets advance to third round of BGCT over Clark Moore

CARLISLE — The Eighth Grade Lady Jackets survived a grueling challenge from Clark Moore Middle School Friday night to claim a 44-33 win in the second round of the Bluegrass Conference Tournament.

The Clark Moore Lady Braves came within one at 10:12 time, but despite a constant challenge, never could slip into the lead.

Defense came to the Lady Jackets aid in the second half, holding the Braves to nine points through two quarters.

But full court press defense also forced the Lady Jackets to take some chances under pressure.

In the first quarter, Shanta McNabb hit for two points on a layup throw while out of control on the court. The points, however, gave the Jackets back out of the fire with a 5-0 lead.

The Braves went on a roll, giving the game at five apiece and keeping the Jackets out of goal range with good rebounding.

But the Jackets still managed to hit twice to every one Braves score to keep themselves just out of reach.

With 26 seconds left in a hard fought first quarter, Jennifer Caswell hit for two for a 14-11 lead.

The lead was cut to two with a shot from Brave Meg Hancock.

Into the second the Jackets went for six straight points, highlighted by a rebound bucket from Sara Simon off a miss by McNabb, to pull themselves out of a tight situation, but it became very evident the Braves weren't likely to coast.

They moved within three with less than three minutes left in the half.

Any Hailfall brought the Jackets back out of the fire with two from the charity stripe. Then McNabb passed off to Kathy Schanding inside for two.
