

NCHS council acts on Algebra I issue

CARLISLE - The Nicholas County High School Board-School Board Council voted 5-0 Tuesday night to prohibit eight-grade students from receiving high-school credit for Algebra I courses beginning next school year.

The council's reasoning was based on what it stated as a need for students to take more advanced math courses, such as Calculus and Trigonometry in their final high school years.

Algebra I is also offered at the high-school level, according to the council.

Nicholas County seniors are required to have three math credits to graduate.

"Many students will take a credit in elementary school,

then go to the senior level and say they don't need this credit," said Council member Jim Simmons.

"Then they get into a class and at around a second year they say they don't need it."

Algebra I will still be offered at the elementary school level.

The state has the power to disregard the council's ruling, according to state law.

The council also voted 5-0 to begin work on a re-curriculum, extra-curricular participation policy. Its intent will be to govern the behavior of students in school athletics and all other extra-curricular programs.

Approved activities of the upward Bound program.

Approved a Special Olympics field trip.

Approved use of the NCHS class car wash and approved a SMAP competition field trip to ECU.
