Phyllis Guthrie, teacher, Nicholas County Schools was recently named as a Region Five Associate. Approximately forty people participated in six days of training coordinated by the Kentucky Department of Education Region Five Service Center. The training was held in July and August at the Ashland Old Building in Lexington. This training was designed to enhance leadership skills needed to form learning teams and learning communities. Similar training programs are being conducted by Regional Service Centers across the state. Eight Regional Service Centers were established in the spring of 1992 as part of the Kentucky Education Reform Act to assist local districts as they implement KEBA. The Region Five Service Center is located at the University of Kentucky campus and serves twenty-three school districts in Central Kentucky.

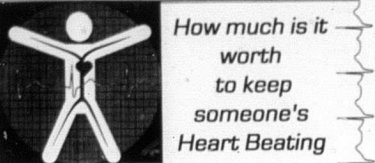
### Abnee receives scholarship
