"Tommy was good fire chief," Vaughn said. "That is to see him."

Assistant Fire Chief James Barry will handle the duties of chief until permanent appointment is made by council January.

Accountant Charles Brunker of the Cynthiana firm Morris, Ingram, and Brunker presented council with his findings after auditing city finances.

This audit is for the year ending June 30, 1993, Brunker said. "All procedures used by the city conform to generally accepted accounting practice."

Brunker outlined expenditures and receipts made by the city, saying the expenditures were about \$80,000 over the previous year.

Brunker said no material weaknesses were present in the fiscal structure of the city, and made four recommendations to the council.

Brunker advised council exactly what portion of the audit report must be published in the newspaper, and made three further recommendations.

Brunker's second recommendation also dealt with accounts receivable. "Any change the clerk needs to make to accounts receivable should be presented to the council or a designated member of council," Brunker said.

Brunker recommended the book recording deposits on the utilities account be balanced more frequently.

Brunker also advised council that no violations on the statute requiring any expenditure of \$10,000 or more be open to bid were items where you came close to violation, but didn't go over," Brunker said.
