I SHALL FOLLOW the accepted principles of efficient and effective administration and management as the principle criteria for my judgments and decisions in the allocation of resources and the operations of my agency. I SHALL HIRE AND PROMOTE only those individuals who are the most qualified candidates for a position according to accepted standards of objectivity and merit. I shall not permit election financing and related factors to influence hiring or promotion practices. I SHALL ENSURE that all employees are granted relevant training and receive in the performance of their duties so that competent and excellent service is provided by the Office of the Sheriff.

I SHALL ENSURE that during my tenure as Sheriff, I shall not use the Office of Sheriff for private gain.

I ACCEPT AND WILL ADHERE TO THIS CODE OF ETHICS. In so doing, I accept responsibility for encouraging others in my profession to abide by this code.

Again, the National Sheriff's Association wrote the Code of Ethics and it has been adopted by the Kentucky Sheriff's Association as the standard of conduct by which all sheriffs in Kentucky should abide; those who will remain in office and those who will be newly elected in November.

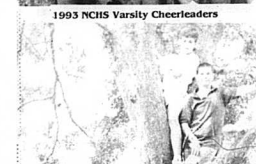
