

Organ recipients celebrate new lease on life

Organ recipients have had to shun their friends, stay home from work and avoid the sun. But they wouldn't have it any other way.

We get to live again now, instead of exist," said Tim Mallicoat, along with Steve Tilley of Richmond and Pamela (Kirkby) More of Oxford, Ohio, all received kidney transplants within the past two months through the Eastern Indiana Kidney Center in Richmond.

Since being released from the Indianapolis hospital where all received their transplants, they have taken medication that helps their body accept their new kidney.

However, the medication does that by knocking out their immune system. As a result, they can get sick more easily.

By avoiding crowds, they are less likely to come down with contagious diseases. But even occasional visits to friends can be life-threatening.

Within a week after one of Mallicoat's friends came to welcome him home from the hospital, Tim was in Indianapolis' Methodist Hospital's critical care unit with complications from the chicken pox.

His friend did not know he was coming down with shingles, which is caused by the same virus that causes chicken pox.

Luckily, Mallicoat and his new kidney survived the ordeal.

But it was a somber reminder of how careful transplant recipients must be.

More has feared catching even a cold since the came home. Because her body rejected the kidney at first, she must have daily blood tests at the Oxford hospital to check her progress.

Although the confinement and isolation are sometimes frustrating, it is a small price to pay for the kidneys that have ended the months of listlessness brought on by

their kidney problems. Before the transplant, More was working four days a week, and each day she came home and collapsed.

"I just couldn't do it any more," she said. "It's amazing. I can't believe it."
