

## Hospital offers disposal program

It is a reality in the world today that there are certain very dangerous diseases that can be spread through contact with blood and certain body fluids. At Bourbon General Hospital we have policies for handling and disposal of contaminated needles and other contaminated materials that meet or exceed stringent state and federal regulations. Bourbon General Hospital is concerned about protecting our community and our environment. We are aware that

there are people who must give injections at home and we are concerned that these needles and syringes may not be disposed of properly. Recently, one of our employees suggested that the hospital start a program to allow for safe disposal of needles that are used

by persons in our community. Small puncture-resistant "sharps containers" may be picked up free of charge Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. at Bourbon General Hospital in Materials Management Department. When the containers are approximately three-fourths full, they should be closed tightly and brought to our Emergency Room Department at any time.
