

DOE offers grants for alternative fuels

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is making \$700,000 available to fund 10 projects nationwide to demonstrate the use of alternative fuels in heavy-duty state or municipal vehicles.

Last year, the Kentucky Department of Energy and the Franklin County School System were awarded a similar grant of \$68,000 to help fund the purchase of four school buses fueled by compressed natural gas (CNG).



The grant will fund the difference in purchase cost between four alternate-fueled ODM (original equipment manufacturer) heavy-duty vehicles and four standard vehicles. Alternate fuels are defined as natural gas, propane, methanol, ethanol, or biodiesel. Dual-fuel vehicles means are not eligible for this solicitation. Potential benefits from the use of alternative fuels include reduced fuel costs, maintenance requirements, and exhaust emissions. Any state or municipal agency that has a concept for a project is asked to contact the Kentucky Division of Energy by the federal Energy Department to submit one and only one project proposal by 7:00 p.m. (EST) 5/20/93. Project ideas must be communicated to that state and municipal agencies office no later than June 1.

Peer group helps teens

Adolescents talk to other adolescents about their problems more often than any other group or person. A survey taken in 1985-1986 discovered that addressees turned to: Friends 38%, Parents 26%, Relative 10%, Adult Friend 8%, Nobody 6%, Clinic 4%, School Counselor 3%, Clergy, Coach, Teacher, Activity Director 15%. For this reason the P.E.E.R. HELPING/PEER NURTURING PROGRAM

was developed. The goal of the Peer Helper program is to train a nucleus of students who can help meet the needs of their peers in the school environment. These students, once equipped, can help address issues such as, substance abuse, sex, pregnancy, abuse (physical, sexual, etc.), grades, relationships, etc. The program participants develop a variety of skills and activities to meet these needs. Each program is developed to meet its own unique needs with its own unique individuals. What peer helping is not... Peer helping is not counseling; we do not teach students to be therapists. Peer Helping is a support program for other students - students learn to discuss options and refer their peers to trained adults for solutions. Peer helping is not taking responsibility for another student's and higher problems - helpers are taught to respect boundaries and to take responsibility only for their own thoughts, feelings and actions. Peer helping is... listening, empathizing, discussing options, and directing those persons with problems to trained adults. Peer Helping is being a friend.
