

Association to hold cultural events

The Arts & Cultural Association of Nicholas County presents two events this week, and May 21 and 22. Admission is free to both events.

The Stewart Home School handbells and special chorus from Frankfort will perform a concert Friday evening at 8 p.m. at Nicholas County Elementary school. Handicapped access to the school will be available through the entrance to the gymnasium, beginning at 6:30.

The Stewart Home School handbells and special chorus are made up of men and women who are mentally retarded. Their musical performances give an opportunity to see and hear the musical talents and abilities, rather than disabilities, of this group of very special people who have faced great challenges in their lives.

Since 1893, The Stewart Home School has provided educational programs and community that enrich the lives of its residents in an environment that seeks quality in every respect.

Contributions will be accepted to the Arts & Cultural

Association to help defray the costs of organizing and presenting such events to the community. Association membership applications will also be available for individuals and families.

On Saturday, May 22, an all-day Arts & Crafts Fair will be held from 10 a.m. till 6 p.m. at the Carlisle Depot and in the building at the corner of Main and Locust (formerly Country Collectibles and Carlisle Florist).

Throughout the day, artists and craftspersons from Nicholas County, Appalachia and other areas of Kentucky will demonstrate their skills, conducting demonstrations, workshops, and seminars on their particular specialty in arts and crafts.

Items will be available for sale, but the primary focus of the fair is education and appreciation, gained through actual working demonstrations.

Admission is also free to the Arts & Crafts Fair, including all displays, demonstrations, seminars, and workshops.

The Arts & Cultural Association of Nicholas County was formed in 1992 with the aid of a \$1,000 New Community Grant awarded by the Kentucky Arts Council. Its stated purpose is to encourage and support local artists and artisans, to offer arts and cultural programs to the community, and to provide education and learning opportunities for all residents of Nicholas County.

Future planning projects for the Association include (1) a "Heritage Festival," featuring visual art, music and dance that have their roots in

various cultures, such as African-American and Native American heritage, and (2) the planting of a "Children's Community Christmas Tree," with children being taught to make original ornaments and decorations for display as annual artistic expressions of the community's children at Christmas.

Long range plans include acquisition of a location and development of a community theatre group that would bring live stage performances to the community on a regular basis.
