institutions," Shephard said. "We may not provide all the services larger hospitals and nursing homes do, but we are not...

"We teach patients how to use their medication and control Diabetes through a combination of medication, diet and exercise," Rose said.
Eula Spears, manager of the Department for Health Services Diabetes control program, said education is the key to controlling the disease.
"Education is where the services of a local health department become very important," Spears said. "With Diabetes, medical care is important. But a physician can't help you with the disease on a day-to-day basis..."

And unlike a governmental institution, a survey team consisting of health professionals routinely provides consultation and education to Asheson. Mathers staff members are an integral part of the survey.
The Joint Commission is currently preparing to be a representative of the American College of Physicians, the American Dental Association, the American Hospital Association, and three members of the public unfamiliar with any of the above.
The Joint Commission evaluates more than 8,000 hospitals and evaluate and accredit parts of the survey. Miller and Shephard gave praise to staff members.
"The hospital and nursing home staff worked very hard to see this accreditation process through and maintain the level of health care that the Joint Commission demands," Miller said.

Diabetes may take other agents to help control their disease. In some health department programs, such as the pre-natal program, glucose testing is performed.
"We can do a finger stick to read the glucose level, but the best of five hour glucose tolerance testing is only done on a prenatal program," Rose said. And working out an individual program which meets individual needs is important.
Not every person with Diabetes has the same needs, but everyone who must deal with this disease needs the information health department offices and educators can provide.
"We can teach all Diabetics how to use their medication, all about the specifics of the disease and the importance of a regulated diet and exercise program and also how to monitor their glucose level," Rose said.
