Extension Notes

"Valmoneid old man winter at this time of the year means checking out a house that has a chimney," says Melba Burch, Extension Agent for Home Economics. Also don't forget to check out the fireplace and chimney too advises Bill Murphy, UK Extension Housing Specialist. "There are more home fires each year from fireplaces than from any other conventional heating equipment."
 Both Melba Burch, Nicholas County Extension Home Economics Agent and Bill Murphy from UK College of Agriculture, advise "to look up the chimney for bird nests or other blockages and plan to sweep the chimney clean if it appears to be caked with creosote soot." A chimney sweep can be hired or a homeowner can do the job with materials found at most building supply stores.
 "If the chimney goes through the attic, check for signs of soot in the attic which might indicate a leaking chimney," Murphy added. "A leaking chimney could be fatal during a chimney fire, which occurs more often than you might think."
 Melba Burch also advises homeowners to check the fireplace damper to see how well it seals. An open damper lets in much air leak out of a house as an open door and can cost the homeowner in higher heating bills. KU offers safety tips

In order for holidays to be more safer and thus more enjoyable, Kentucky Utilities Company offers some tips on electrical safety.
 When decorating for Christmas, connect decorative lights to multi-outlet power strips that contain their own breakers. Also, don't run cords under rugs, through doorways, around sharp corners, or over radiators or pipes. Locate cords where they won't create a tripping hazard.
 Never overload circuits or extension cords. Follow the manufacturer's guidelines for the number and type of light strings that can be linked together safely.
 When hooking up lights check for damaged insulation, cracked sockets or bare wires.
 When using lights for outdoor use only those decorations made specifically for outdoor use. Use ground fault circuit interrupters for added safety.
 Many residents set up the Christmas tree right after the Thanksgiving turkey is eaten.
 But even Christmas trees can be a safety risk if proper safety measures are not followed.
 The tree should be located well away from heat sources that could dry it out: heating radiators, the fireplace, or the television.
 Keep the tree standing filled with water and preservative to prevent the tree from drying out. If an artificial tree is used, choose one that is fire-resistant. Never string electric lights on a metal tree.
 And remember, don't use water on an electrical fire. Unplug all holiday decorative lights before leaving the house or go to bed. For more electrical safety information call 289-2242.
