Crawford enrolled in honors program

A Nicholas County student, Rubabah Crawford, junior political science major, is enrolled in Eastern Kentucky University's Honors Program. The program, launched in 1986, is designed especially for intellectually promising students who seek a strong grounding in the liberal arts along with their more specialized major. There are 115 students in the program.

"Eastern's honors Program challenges the brightest students by combining a rigorous academic program with meaningful academic enrichment experiences," said Dr. Bonnie Gray, director. "Such students may be successful in an intellectually intense, small college atmosphere within the context of all the advantages that a large university affords."

One distinctive feature of Eastern's Honors Program is the small class size of no more than 20 students, allowing for individual attention and for one-on-one dialogue with instructors. The 28 credit hour program offers coursework in the humanities, the social sciences and natural sciences, and emphasizes the development of skills in effective communication, in critical thinking, and in the integration of knowledge from various disciplines.

Students in the program have the opportunity to live on an Honors hall, use an Honors common room for study and informal meetings, and perform classwork in the program's computer lab.

Students with excellent academic backgrounds are invited to apply for Eastern's Honors Program. National Merit Examinations and scholastics are automatically accepted. Beyond that, students with high school grade point averages of 3.5 or better on a 4.0 scale and with at least a score of 80 on the American College Test will be given priority, but others demonstrating the potential for outstanding academic performance will be considered. Abundant opportunities for scholarships exist.
