

# Nicholas County's Friday foe beats Fairview

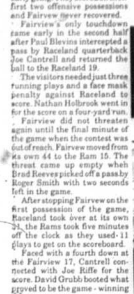

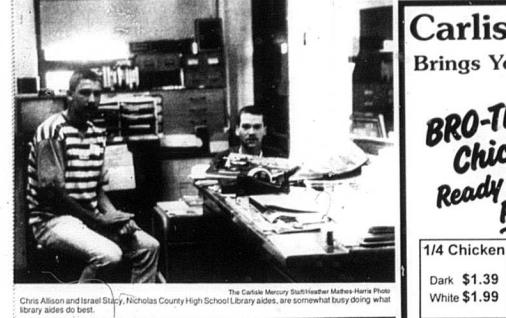
