Childrens' eyes should be checked as part of back to school

As summer vacations come to an end, it is time to tuck the memories of summer camps and enjoyable excursions away and begin preparing for the return back to school. Along with school clothing, paper, pencils, and other school supplies, Dr. Teresa Madden, President of the Kentucky Optometric Foundation, reminds us that one of the most important aspects of learning is to have the basic equipment necessary to obtain a good education. One such tool is clear, comfortable, non-deflection vision. The weeks between the first day of school and the first report card are good times for parents to look for symptoms of vision problems in their children. According to Dr. Madden, a child's behavior and posture while doing schoolwork often suggests clues signaling the need for a complete eye exam.

"A parent's awareness of such symptoms along with a routine vision examination helps us determine the need for special testing to uncover perception problems," comments Dr. Madden. Symptoms parents should look for include frequent clam-
