Sports Lady Jackets take Berea down for count

CARLISLE - Kim Denkins, senior Lady Jacket and University of Kentucky signee, led the 2500 point mark during Nicholas County's win over the Lady Princes of Berea, 66-51.

Daniel Brown, graduate of Nicholas County and current Berea College Mountaineer, holds the Nicholas County High School record with 2543 career points. But Denkins approached that mark, setting the point record for female athletes with 2500 points, 548 left to play in the fourth quarter, with a foul that sealed the Lady Jackets' win over the Lady Princes.

It should be noted, on an ironic twist, that the 2500th point made the score 52-43. Denkins number is 52.

Appropriately, Denkins scored the first points on the board with a shot under nearly a heavily protected basket.

The competition arose between speed and power with the dominating force of Lady Jacket and Mariella Hopkins of the law post and Treva Goodrich of the low post and Hena Goodrich of the player.

Rea played, Hopkins and Denkins broke down on the low post and forced turnover to Nicholas County's favor. Gilbert popped up with another three and led Nicholas 14-8, 2:31 yet to play.

Denkins scored the next four consecutive points, the final two after deftly passing meant for Jacklyn Turner.

However, with 16 seconds left in play, Turner hammered in a three pointer to cut the Lady Jacket lead, 18-12.

Goodrich rattled in the next basket in the second quarter, and after Denkins committed her second foul, Goodrich went two for two as the line - two points down, 18-16.

Hopkins and Sibert teamed up at the corner for the half - court trap, Nicholas County possession and Kenney called time out for strategy, 6:37 to play.

Hopkins scored on the rebound play, but Turner answered with a jumper at the top of the key. With added points by Goodrich, Berea went up 21-20.

However, Treva Lovingsood looked for the mark at the baseline and found it, Nicholas County battling back.

Berea tried to create scoring opportunities by spreading out the offense. However, Tara George and Sibert handled the point up high and forced the point to walk - Nicholas County possession.

Goodrich handed the ball back to Berea by stealing at the half-court mark and rubbed the lane for an added two.

Denkins answered by stripping away the offensive rebound and sank the put-back.

An unlikeliest Hopkins followed suit, even though she was triple-teamed to the point, but Nicholas up 26-23, 1:16 to play.

With 36 seconds to play, Gilbert Schandling refused to let Berea resume its lead and went two for two at the line - hitting the 2500 point mark.

After Denkins committed her fourth foul and Goodrich hit both ends of the bonus, Berea called time out.

When we went down for half time we did make some adjustments. We needed to shut Berea

down quickly in the third and get that solid lead, Kenney said.

In the third quarter, Denkins opened play and Nicholas led 34-23.

On the defensive end, Nicholas stacked strong on Goodrich, but did not leave the weak side unprotected and although the team played aggressively and committed some fouls, they broke down on Berea and forced consecutive turnovers.

Offensively, the Lady Jacket swung their screen into wide berth was provided to an unguarded George who took it to the hole. Goodrich answered with two all her own for the team.

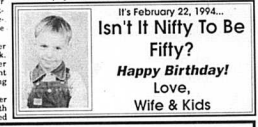
Berea stacked three on Denkins which freed up George who once again, capitalized on the scoring opportunity.
