Donors include: David Daniel Breen, with a 28.3 points-per-game average, is ranked second nationally by the NAIA (National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics) in basketball statistics released January 9.

Breen, a 5-11 sophomore from Carlisle, is second to Dwight Cowan of Schreiner (Texas) College who's averaging 24.3 points. Among NAIA/Kentucky Intercollegiate Athletic Conference scores, Breen is No. 2.

Breen also ranks 14th nationally for individual free throws, connecting on 81 of 104, and is seventh in the nation and second in the conference in individual assists, averaging 7.5 per game.

Breen's Tim Ballinger, a 6-4 junior forward from Greenville, South Carolina, is 16th in the nation and second in the conference in rebounding, averaging 12.1 in nine contests.

In other NAIA standings, Breen is first in free throw percentage, connecting on 31 of 104 attempts. Breen's guard Chris Haggard is fifth with a field goal percentage of .547. Haggard is a 6-2 senior from Lexington, Kentucky, has scored on 58 of 104 field goals.

The Brea College men's team, 6-4 after the January 8 loss to Georgetown, is 3-3 in the NAIA.

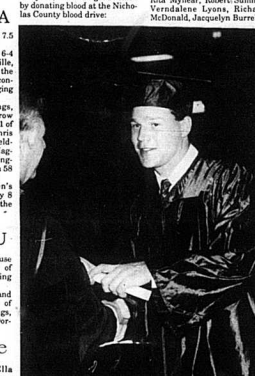
