Flora, daughter of Jim and Martha Flora of Hunt Road, Carlisle, will be the Bluegrass Senior Division Western Pleasure Horse Judge Regional competition at Scott County. The club meets 7 p.m. the second Thursday of each month at the Nicholas County Extension Office. Shelly has three horses now—a Palomino, Racking Horse, and Quarter Horse. "I've been riding for a long time," she said.

"I had my first class in judging horses Sunday morning and I judged Sunday at noon," she said. McFarland added, "She didn't want to do it. She's just kind of figured it out. She's been around horses all her life."

Judging horses involves looking at everything about the horse, from how it moves to how it's built, to how it acts. McFarland said, "It's what the freeman at Nicholas County High School this fall, already has her sights on college. Although she likes being around horses, camping, and playing softball and basketball, she wants to be a therapist."

Shelly volunteers in the activities program at Johnson Maders Nursing Home three times a week, reading letters to residents, playing checkers and just being a good friend, said her mother, Martha.
