**Need A Standby Generator?**

Even a short power outage can result in a significant loss of income for most farmers. Crop drying, milk refrigeration, water pumping, heating and ventilation are some of the operations that rely on electricity. Even though the electric utility is always a service reliability record is more than 99 percent, power outages occur because of wind, snow, ice, trees and other unavoidable events. When a power failure occurs, a properly sized and well maintained standby generator reduces income losses and maintains production. It can pay for itself through avoided loss of production from just a few short periods of power loss.

Remember that emergency generators are not designed to power all. Because a motor's starting current is three to five times greater than its running current, the generator must be sized to handle the starting current of the largest motor, plus all other electric loads that will operate at the same time.

**Lady Jackets hopes for a Sweet Sixteen repeat dash**

**BOWLING GREEN**—An era has ended for Nicholas County High School. With a record of 16 wins and a mere 18 defeats in the last four seasons, fans of the Nicholas County High School Lady Jackets are an unusual sight at the Western Kentucky University's A. Diddle arena on Wednesday, March 16.

The Odham County Lady Colonels received the 1994 Sweet 16 tournament win, with a score of 66 to 49.

It was a blow to Nicholas County fans. The Lady Jackets were the 1993 state champions. They played the first game of the tournament this year.

"We've got some disappointed kids here," noted Girls Basketball Coach Barbara Kenney during a news conference held immediately after the game. "Kim got in early."

Three school buses filled with approximately 150 fans made the three and a half hour journey to watch the game.

"I would like to publicly thank the community for supporting us, not only financially, but they've backed us throughout the season. They came out not just for the tournament, but game per game," Coach Kenney said Monday.

Somehow, consternation began for the Lady Jackets during this year's tournament play.

"I was hurt about the loss. It hurts real bad even now," the coach said Monday.

Senior Kim Donkins, Most Valuable Player in Class A for 1993 and 1994 and Sweet 16 MVP 1993 suffered foul trouble. When she went to the bench

during the second quarter, Elizabeth Schending tried even harder to rally the team's efforts. Coach Kenney commended Schending for her finest performance which added 10 points to the game and four rebounds.

At half-time, the score was tied 21-21. "I was pleased with the effort. I was pleased that they could hold the rebound," Coach Kenney said.

At 1:07 left, Tawnya Livingston brought the Lady Jackets within two points again with a free throw turning the score to 51 to 49 for a game total of five points.

In the last 31 seconds of the game, the Lady Colonels converted 51 of seven free throws.

In a news conference following the game, Lady Jackets Coach Kenney said surrounded by three seniors, Kim Donkins, Elizabeth Schending and Michelle Hopkins.

"I thought we were in good shape," Coach Kenney said of the team's performance during the first "What a six point lead but we just couldn't top that."

Looking for a reason for the loss proved difficult, but Coach Kenney tried to give an explanation. "I thought we played excellent. Maybe not scored, but nervous."

The size of the school enrollment was also a factor mentioned by Odham Coach Mark Evans during the news conference. His county last won the state championship in 1986 and has been to the Sweet 16 a total of 11 times. The high school enrollment is 826.



Odham County's strategy seemed to be quadruple-teaming Miss Basketball candidate Kim Donkins. The Lady Colonels managed to slip by Lady Jackets in Bowling Green with a final tally of 56-49.

The 1994 Sweet 16 tournament marked the end of high school basketball careers for six seniors: Kim Donkins, Elizabeth Schending, Tawnya Livingston, Michelle Hopkins, Elizabeth Schending and Kim Donkins.
