Some Nicholas farmers may qualify for aid

(Lexington, KY, March 16, 1994) — Farmers Home Administration State Director, Thomas G. Fern, today announced that 6 Kentucky counties have been designated to receive emergency loan assistance through FHA's disaster relief program. These counties are: Daviess, Harrison, Henry, Owen, Scott, and Shelby.

In addition to these six counties, 21 other Kentucky counties are named as contiguous counties whereby eligible family farmers may qualify for EM loan assistance. Those counties are: Anderson, Bracken, Bourbon, Carroll, Fayette, Franklin, Gallatin, Grant, Hancock, Henderson, Jefferson, McLean, Nicholas, Ohio, Oldham, Pendleton, Robertson, Spencer, Trimble, and Woodford.

FHA will make physical loss loans up to \$500,000 with a statutory 4.5% interest rate, subject to a test for credit. The actual loan amount will be limited to the amount necessary to restore the farm to its pre-disaster condition. Applications will be received through October 28, 1994.

According to Mr. Fern, loan applications forms may be obtained at the Farmers Home Administration offices serving each county.
