 they do, only a tentative budget can be made, explained Nicholas County Superintendent Robert Gilbert.  
 Coaches didn't receive their raises, nor were teachers and staff awarded raises for long years of service in the tentative budget.  
 "This is a tentative budget. It's just a matter of changing it," stated board member Sammie Vice.

All board members were in attendance: Chairman Louise Zachary, and members David Simot, Sammie Vice, Jimmy Dale, and John Cleaver, as well as Superintendent Robert Gilbert and school board attorney Dawn Lether.  
 Gilbert informed the board he made the tentative budget with the requests of teachers and staff in mind. Teachers had asked at last month's board meeting for at least a five percent salary increase.  
 Cleaver said a best case scenario of state approved budget increase would be \$248,242 increase over last year's budget, a 6.8 percent increase. A worst

case scenario would be a 1 percent increase (\$16,000).  
 Board member John Cleaver said he'd like to know what the state would allow the district before naming salary increases. "It'd be easy if you knew what the budget was," Cleaver commented. He later added, "I don't know if there's extra money or not. Neither of our state representatives I've talked to know."  
 Gilbert contended he had an interest in the district's financial future, even though his contract was up June 30. "I do have a vested interest. My son will graduate from here, my daughter's a student here and my wife teaches here. I may be where you are next year," he told the seated audience.  
 The first action of the board was to approve a sexual harassment policy.  
 Board member David Simot asked, "Are the people who worked on this here?"  
 High school teacher Karla Allison said, "A lot of time and research did not go into this. We felt this was the best we could do. We worked real hard."  
 Travis Huber, a chemistry

teacher at the high school, was on the policy making committee. Huber told the board the policy was thoroughly researched by studying other school annual harassment policies and adopted the best ideas of each policy. Bill Gardner of the Central School Office told The Mercury the staff will receive copies of the policy and copies will be in the school libraries and in the principal and guidance counselor offices. An in-service on the policy will be held this fall, he said.
