Amendment to constitution will appear on ballot

Nicholas Countians will be asked to vote on one amendment to the state constitution when they go vote on November 8, according to Secretary of State Bob Bahkage.
 Voters will be asked if they wish to amend the state constitution to require cities, counties and taxing districts to adopt a balanced budget prior to each fiscal year.
 If passed the amendment would prohibit these local government taxing units from spending more than they take in each budget cycle.
 The amendment would also allow the General Assembly to classify cities based on factors other than population alone.
 Currently Kentucky has six classes of cities which are determined by population.
 If passed, the amendment would also allow the General Assembly to authorize cities to exercise any power of function that furthers a public purpose and does not conflict with constitutional or statutory provision.
 With voter approval the amendment would also allow the General Assembly to make laws regarding the extension, boundaries, form of government, functions and officers of cities.
