Younger women, roughly 30 or younger, should undergo a baseline mammogram. If there exists a family history of breast cancer, mammograms are advised to consult their doctor about scheduling a regular series of mammograms rather than just the screening. They should have a baseline done at an earlier age.

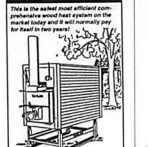
