president says farm program fails family farmers

LOUISVILLE - According to a news release from the Kentucky Farm Bureau Federation, the Clinton administration policies that are hurting family farmers by providing insufficient financial security for family farms, a White House agriculture official said in the Kentucky Farm Bureau Convention.

Marion Berry, special assistant to the president for Agricultural Trade and Food Assistance, said the 1995 Farm Bill that is expected to pass Congress places farmers at greater risk by calling for a seven-year phase out of price support programs.

"Historically, agriculture policy is non-partisan. That hasn't been the case this year," Berry said at a luncheon meeting of about 600 Kentucky farmers.
