Superintendent's Notebook

What to Teach, How to Teach It, and Why to Teach It.

So far, most educational reform has focused on the regulatory parts of school renewal. It is now time to apply a test of quality to educational reform, which is at the very heart of public education.

FIRST TEST: Will we teach students what they need to know? No amount of rhetoric can conceal that in most states the K-12 curriculum lacks both quality and coherence. We have added Carnegie units to our graduation requirements, but have failed to ask, "What is the history? What is the science? What is the math? What is the English?"

SECOND TEST: The next question is where do we begin? The first curriculum priority is that all students must become proficient in the written and the spoken word. On this point we all agree. What we must agree upon, it seems, is the level of literacy to be attained. Will we settle for the embarrassing elementary vocabulary tests now required in some states, even at the college level? Is that what it means to be linguistically proficient?
