A Living Trust Instead of a Will?
A living trust is one of the newer estate planning tools that takes the place of a will. A living trust is a legal entity created by the state to hold title to assets. It is an alternative that avoids the costs of probate when a loved one dies and saves the heirs money. Says Melba A. Burch, Nicholas County Extension Agent for Home Economics and Dr. Suzanne Badenhop, UK Extension Specialist for Household Equipment and Management. Other names for the living trust are revocable trust, changed will trust, inter vivos trust, family trust and grantor trust. All these names refer to the same trust. Dr. Badenhop advises that The Clifford Trust and the Constitutional Family Trust are not the same as a living trust and should not be confused with it. Under probate, whether one estate is probated or not, the estate must be probated to distribute the property of the deceased to the heirs. Probate costs include probate fees, federal estate inheritance taxes, attorney's fees and other expenses associated with setting up the trust. Most estate planning attorneys recommend the revocable living trust as a solution to avoid the probate process. In a revocable living trust, the trustor remains alive and retains control of the trust assets. You do not hold title to the trust assets. The trustor of the living trust, the trustee, often serves as the trustee of the trust. With a probated estate, all documents become public information during the probate process, including a will if one exists and an inventory of assets. Special provisions can be made in a living trust for the surviving spouse, those assets can then go to the individuals specified by the original spouse.

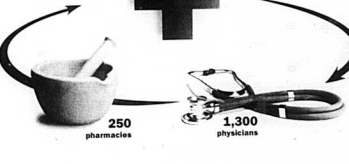
