LEXINGTON, KY—How the 1995 burley auction sales schedule starts and finishes may vary from previous season, if U.S. Ac Secretary Dan Glickman approves proposals developed today by the Burley Tobacco Advisory Committee. Dates that the 39-member federal panel recommended to Glickman are:
*Pre-market Weigh-in & Grading Start: Mon., Nov. 6
*Last Sale Day Before Christmas: Thurs., Dec. 14
*Market Reopens: Mon., Jan. 29
*Market Closes: Thurs., Feb. 23
According to William M. Rod' Kugel, Jr., BTAC chairman, the major differences that growers may see in the upcoming season include:
*That farmers will have the option to have their burley weighed and graded more uniformly during the 14-day pre-market period; and
*There will be no cleanup warehouse auctions after Feb. 29.

Final crop reporting date extended until July 31

LEXINGTON, KY—Hamilton Henton, Jr., Acting State Executive Director of the Consolidated Farm Service Agency (formerly AS2C) for Kentucky, announced today that the 1995 final crop reporting date for corn, grain sorghum, soybeans, tobacco, and all uninsured crops in Kentucky has been extended from July 15 to July 31. Henton explained that farmers are required to report

their program acreage to establish their eligibility to receive benefits. Average reports are required for all farms participating in the Acreage Reduction Program and Conservation Reserve Program, and farms that purchased crop insurance from FSA.
