Ky. boaters face few changes

1994 brought a few changes for Kentucky boaters. The Division of Water Patrol was transferred to the Tourism Cabinet and placed under the Dept. of Fish and Wildlife Resources. The Division of Water Patrol has about forty officers to patrol the waters of the Commonwealth. The enforcement of the Dept. of Fish and Wildlife has a Conservation Officer assigned to each of 120 counties. With these Officers now checking for boating violations in more remote areas they are finding many boaters are not aware of the current boating regulations. Hopefully this article can answer a few questions and clear up some misconceptions about the boating regulations.

Park system installs info line

FRANKFORT - The Kentucky State Park System is expanding the service of its 1,800-254-PARK information line effective Feb. 14. The automated call processing system will operate 24 hours a day, seven days a week throughout the year. Callers will be able to obtain information about a specific resort park or about resort parks located in a particular region of the state. Other features on the automated menu are a listing of special events in the parks and an option to request printed literature on any park in the system. During regular business hours, Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. E.T., callers may also speak to a live attendant. This system is also accessible to callers using a TDD-Telecommunication Device for the Deaf. For immediate access to the TDD menu, callers should press 7 immediately after the system answers. Unlike other systems, ring signaling devices and closed captioning capabilities are available at other parks. Annative listening devices are also available at other parks with conference centers.

5. Alcohol Consumption Ky. law prohibits drinking while boating in public places and most waterways are public places. It is also against the law to operate a boat while drinking or under the influence of alcohol.

6. Signaling Devices All boats 16 ft. and over must have a horn, whistle or other mechanical sound producing device capable of producing a blast of (2) seconds or more. 7. Backlash Operation Speed is one of the main causes of boating accidents. When operating a boat be aware of the wake produced by your boat or by your wake. Many areas have wake or idle speed only regulations. (Idle Speed) means the slowest possible speed maintain maneuverability.

8. These are a few of the laws that cause the most problems for boaters. Violation of these regulations usually result in a citation to the operator of the boat and many times they must return to dock to correct the problem. There are boaters that have never read the safety rules that a boater needs to know.
