Rural Economic and Community Development Administration is having a Rural Guaranty Housing Meeting on June 22, 1995, at the Fleming County Library, 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. The meeting will discuss any potential home buyer who may qualify for the Guaranty Program. The Program will consist of helping fill out the application for the Lender, assist in determining the income limits, deductions, ratios, debt repayment, etc. Income guidelines for one person, single, starting at \$14,000; adjusted gross for a family of 4 per household of \$28,500. Example: an average family of 4 per household, the adjusted gross may be \$23,000 for Fleming, Nicholas and Adams Counties. There should be active lenders at the meeting to answer questions regarding interest rates, terms, closing costs, etc. If you are considering purchasing a home, please attend.
