One special man buried there is Private First Class Franklin R. Souley. Souley was fighting on two Jimas with the 5th Marine Division when he fell went out for volunteers to raise the U. S. Flag on Mt. Suribachi. Souley was a Squad Leader, Sergeant Swanik volunteered his Browning machine rifle Squad (B.A.R.) to raise the flag.

Souley was among the 15 to 20 men who went up the mountain. When the group arrived, after a hard climb and fight, Souley helped raise the American flag for all the Marines and Japanese to see.

O'Neal survived the assault on two Jimas without being wounded. He was discharged from service on December 30, 1945 and returned to Nicholas County to continue farming. Today his farms and live stock on the California Road in the Bartelsville area of Nicholas County.
